

REPORT: OPHTHALMOLOGY UPDATE





MA Mumbai West branch organized CME ophthalmology Update on the occasion of DOCTORS DAY on SUNDAY, 29.06.25. The eminent speakers delivered talk on the important topics:

Dr. Vaishal Kenia: Outlined lucidly newer techniques in Cataract surgery. Such as Bifocal, Trifocal and Continuous focus intraocular lenses, it's advantages. Femtosecond laser assisted cataract extraction and it's reduced morbidity. He dwelt on newer options in LASIK surgery to get rid of spectacles, Lasik surgery for Presbyopia.

Dr. Hazare: Took us through the causes and treatment modalities for Diabetic retinopathy, which in near future will be major problem, as India will be predicted Diabetes capital of the World. Advantages and limitations of intravitreal injections of immunomodulators and uses of Green Lasers in treating retinopathy.

Dr. Sneha Maru: Explained Common Corneal Diseases, seen by general physicians. REPORT: IMA CGP SUB FACULTY

- On 8th June, ONCOLOGY UPDATE a joint venture between MOC and IMA Mumbai West was held at Hotel Ginger, Vile Parle. Over 300 delegates attended. Dr Ashish Joshi and his team of doctors updated the delegates on the various treatments available in Oncology. After each lecture there were Quiz questions. The entire CME was in the form of panel. discussions that were very informative and interactive.
- On **10**th **June** there was a **hybrid CME on MIGRAINE** jointly organised by IMA HQs, Hyderabad City and Mumbai West branch, where 109 delegates attended the physical CME.

How migraine can affect multiple aspects of individual's life was explained. Multiple factors acting as triggers for migraine attack like stress, irregular sleep, caffeine, dehydration etc. were explained too. Differential diagnosis of migraine were discussed e.g. Acute Glaucoma, subdural hematoma, Acute severe hypertension, Intracranial neoplasm, sinusitis etc. The goals of managing acute attack were told including pharmacological management, life style advice etc. Neuro modulation devices and Botox...... recent advances in Migraine treatment were told.

 - **Dr. Tushar Shah** discussed Multivitamins Role in our Daily Diet and various preparations available today.
 - **Dr. Samir Parikh** explained the differences between GU and DU...and that between PPI and Vonaprazan and what to use when.

- Then **Dr. Nimesh Mehta** gave PPT presentation on Ocular Trauma, explaining in great detail various eye injuries and their medical and surgical treatment. MRI is contraindicated for metallic Foreign body. The Aim being to preserve and salvage precious gift of sight.
- **Dr. Manan Sheth** guided on the latest protocol followed in Ovarian Stimulation in IUI and IVF. Infertility is due to:

40% attributed to Female partner

30% to Male

20% Combined in both.

10% Unexplained..

Use of Letrozole, Clomiphene and Gonadotropin was explained.


All in all, the CME'S held in June 2025 were well appreciated by delegates as they imparted practical knowledge to GP.

 - Emerging therapies such as cultured endothelial cell injection, limbal stem cell transplantation and iPSC-derived tissue engineering are redefining the future
 - Artificial corneas (keratoprostheses) offer hope for patients with multiple graft failures and complex ocular surface disease
 - The integration of Al, gene therapy & regenerative medicine is expected to transform corneal care into a more personalized, accessible and less invasive field

REPORT: HYPERTENSION DETECTION CAMP





ndian Medical Association Mumbai West branch joined for a **Hypertension Detection Camp** along with a Multi Speciality Camp organised by Rotary Club of Bombay West.

The camp was at Shruti School, Near PVR Cinema, Juhu on **Sunday, 15th June, 2025** from **9.00 am to 1.00 pm**. Members Dr. Bhavna Patel, Dr. Subash Gajria and Dr. Vinodini Karnik participated in the camp. Approximately 100 people were examined.

60 were senior citizens out of which 5 were above 80 yrs, in these 5 BP was in control, other 30 seniors had good control. 10 had not taken their morning dose of BP & hence BP was high while 5 did not have high BP. 20 young people were seen. 10 had high normal BP. They were taking tobacco & were advised to stop, rest 10 had normal BP. 20 on medications had average reading 134/94 mm hg

Some of young persons 5 to 7 in nos were having HIGH BP without family history & without being aware. They were on to mobile all the time, sacrificing their night sleep also.

With their clinical history it appeared -they had stressful life, fast food habits and lack of exercise - may be leading to high BP. Living Healthy Lifestyle with balanced diet, regular exercise, weight control and Medical check ups were suggested to them.
