Let us continue to uphold the values of Knowledge, Service and Unity in Building a Healthier India.

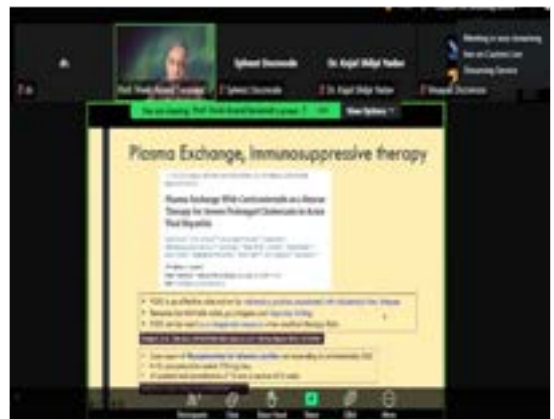

- The first academic session was a **panel discussion** on **"Migraine Update."** The session was moderated by Dr. Bimal Shah, with Dr. Jayesh Lele, Dr. Kishor Shetty and Dr. Ashish Purohit serving as panelists. Dr. Bimal Shah initiated the discussion with a series of questions on various aspects of migraine, to which the panelists provided comprehensive and insightful responses. The discussion covered the etiology and different types of migraine, with particular emphasis on the importance of detailed history-taking for accurate diagnosis. The panelists also discussed evidence-based treatment strategies for the various types of migraine and shared practical clinical insights for effective patient management.
- The second lecture was delivered by **Dr. Ketan Mehta**, Physician, on the topic **"Beyond the Hype: Why Innovator Semaglutide's Proven Legacy Sets the Gold Standard in Obesity Management."** Dr. Mehta highlighted obesity as a major global health priority and discussed the mechanism of action of semaglutide. He elaborated on its role in managing obesity and associated comorbidities such as Metabolic Dysfunction-Associated Steatohepatitis (MASH) and cardiovascular disease (CVD). He also reviewed data from various clinical trials demonstrating approximately 20% reduction in body weight and BMI with semaglutide therapy. Additionally, he explained the differences between synthetic and mRNA-based semaglutide.
- The third lecture was delivered by **Dr. Pranav Ghody**, Endocrinologist, on the topic **"Optimising T2D Care with Innovator Semaglutide : Start Right, Start Strong."** Dr. Ghody discussed the role of semaglutide in the management of

diabetes and emphasized the importance of achieving tight glycaemic control to prevent both microvascular and macrovascular complications of diabetes. He also highlighted the benefits of semaglutide in patients with type 2 diabetes and associated comorbidities, advocating its early and appropriate use in suitable patients.

Date: 5th July 2026- The Next-Gen Seminar

CME Convener : Dr. B. M. Inamdar

- The first lecture was delivered by **Dr. Gaurav Kulkarni**, Psychiatrist, on the topic **"Understanding Gender Dysphoria & Identities."** He began by explaining the concepts of gender identity and gender expression, highlighting the differences between the two. He discussed gender dysphoria, its prevalence in India, clinical presentation, psychological impact, diagnostic criteria and available treatment & support options. Dr. Kulkarni emphasized the importance of empathy, sensitivity, and a patient-centred approach while caring for individuals experiencing gender dysphoria.
- The second lecture was delivered by **Dr. Nishad Situt**, Orthopaedic Surgeon, on the topic **"Neck Pain in the Smartphone Era : A Practical Approach."** He discussed the common causes of neck pain, with particular focus on the effects of prolonged smartphone and computer use. He explained the anatomy of the cervical spine, including the role of bones, muscles, and ligaments in providing support and stability and described how poor posture contributes to neck pain. He elaborated on various causes of discogenic pain, available treatment modalities, the importance of physiotherapy and neck-strengthening exercises and the role of surgery as a last resort. He stressed the need for ergonomic corrections and maintaining proper posture while using

mobile phones and computers.

- The third lecture was delivered by **Dr. Riya Bimal Shah**, Dentist, on the topic **“The Mouth as a Mirror : Oral Manifestations of Systemic Pathology.”** She explained the pathophysiology of oral manifestations associated with systemic diseases and highlighted xerostomia as an important clinical finding. She discussed the oral manifestations seen in cardiovascular, renal, dermatological, hepatic, haematological, autoimmune & infectious diseases, emphasizing the importance of oral examination in the early detection of systemic illnesses.
- The fourth lecture was delivered by **Dr. Siddharth Warrior**, Neurophysician, on the topic **“The Mind-Body Connection: Neuropsychology of Pain.”** Drawing upon the Gate Control Theory and the Neuromatrix Theory of pain, he explained the complex relationship between emotions and pain perception. He discussed how chronic stress leads to elevated cortisol levels, resulting in a reduced pain threshold and contributing to chronic pain syndromes. He also highlighted the role of cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT), mindfulness-based stress reduction, and biofeedback as valuable non-pharmacological approaches in pain management.

The interactive question-and-answer sessions following each lecture were well received, with enthusiastic participation from the delegates, making the academic discussions highly engaging and informative. The CME concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the distinguished faculty, delegates, organizers, and sponsors for their valuable contributions towards the success of the program.

- The first lecture was delivered by

Dr. Rashmi Mehta, Surgeon, on the topic **“Topical Analgesics in Everyday Practice.”** She began by discussing the advantages of topical analgesics in the management of acute and chronic pain. She explained their mechanism of action, active ingredients, clinical indications, and potential side effects. Dr. Mehta elaborated on the role of topical rubefacients and highlighted the importance of capsaicin, particularly in the management of post-herpetic neuralgia. She also reviewed the various combination topical analgesic preparations currently available and provided valuable insights into emerging developments and future advances in topical pain management.

- The second lecture was delivered by **Dr. Gulshan Rohra**, CVTS Surgeon, on the topic **“Simplifying the Bentall Procedure.”** He provided an overview of the Bentall procedure, discussing its indications, surgical principles, and clinical applications. Through the presentation of several operative cases from his own experience, he demonstrated practical aspects of the procedure and shared valuable surgical insights. He also reviewed the different types of prosthetic valves available, outlining their respective advantages and considerations. Dr. Rohra highlighted the quality and reliability of Indian-manufactured prosthetic valves and expressed his preference for their use whenever appropriate and acceptable to patients.
- The third session was conducted by **Mr. Dadich Bhatt & Dr. Gaurav Khemka** from Wealth Cube Endeavours LLP on the topic of **financial management for medical professionals**. They discussed the importance of financial planning and wealth management for doctors, with particular emphasis on mutual fund investments as an effective long-term

wealth creation strategy. The speakers also highlighted the need for systematic financial planning to ensure financial security and achieve personal and professional goals.

- The first lecture was delivered by **Dr. Bimal Shah**, ENT Surgeon, on the topic **"An Approach to a Case of Nasal Discharge."** He discussed the various types of rhinorrhoea, their underlying causes, and the appropriate treatment strategies based on the etiology. He explained the role of different topical and combination decongestant medications in clinical practice and highlighted supportive measures such as steam inhalation. Dr. Shah also provided an overview of Functional Endoscopic Sinus Surgery (FESS) as an advanced surgical option for selected patients. The session concluded with a simple and practical algorithm summarizing the management of different types of rhinorrhoea.
- The second lecture was delivered by **Dr. Subhraprakash Sanyal**, Hematologist, on the topic **"Managing Malignant Hematological Disorders and the Role of HSCT."** He provided an overview of the various hematological malignancies and discussed their current management strategies. Special emphasis was placed on the role of Hematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation (HSCT), including its indications, patient selection, and evolving techniques. Dr. Sanyal also highlighted recent advances in transplantation that have contributed to improved patient outcomes and faster recovery.
- The third lecture was delivered by Dietitian **Noopur Mehta** on the topic **"Can AI Replace a Dietitian?"** She

explored the growing role of artificial intelligence in nutrition planning and demonstrated how AI platforms, including ChatGPT, can assist in preparing personalized diet plans. She emphasized the importance of using well-structured prompts to generate accurate and clinically useful dietary recommendations for different categories of patients. The session also showcased various AI platforms, outlining their applications, strengths, and limitations in dietetics. She concluded by emphasizing that while AI can serve as a valuable support tool, the expertise and clinical judgment of a qualified dietitian remain essential for individualized patient care.

Date: 30th July 2026 : Diabetic Foot

- Welcome and introduction by **Dr. Bimal Shah & Dr. Bhavna Patel**, who welcomed the faculty members and delegates and highlighted the importance of early diagnosis & comprehensive management of diabetic foot.
- The first lecture was delivered by **Dr. Ketan Mehta**, Physician, on the topic **"Clinician's Role in Early Prevention."** He began by discussing the prevalence, pathophysiology, risk factors and management of diabetic foot infections. He emphasized the pivotal role of primary care physicians in the prevention, early detection, and timely management of diabetic foot complications to reduce morbidity and prevent amputations.
- The second lecture was delivered by **Prof. Dr. Milind Ruke**, Surgeon, on the topic **"Diabetic Foot: Chronic Wound Protocols."** He explained the pathophysiology of diabetic foot syndrome and the biomechanics of the gait cycle. He highlighted the importance of offloading as a key component in the management of diabetic foot ulcers and demonstrated various treatment

modalities for chronic wounds. He also discussed the emerging role of artificial intelligence in newer approaches to diabetic foot management.

- The third lecture was delivered by **Dr. Raghuram Sekhar**, Endovascular Surgeon, on the topic "**Limb Vascularisation in Diabetic Foot.**" He discussed the pathophysiology of diabetic foot ulcers and the significance of ischemia in diabetic patients. He introduced advanced vascular imaging techniques such as **CO₂ angiography** and explained the role of balloon angioplasty and intravascular lithotripsy in managing severely calcified arterial blockages. He emphasized the importance of a multidisciplinary approach in the treatment of ischemic diabetic foot ulcers and gangrene to improve limb salvage

outcomes.

- The interactive question-and-answer sessions following each lecture were highly engaging and well appreciated by the delegates. The active participation and exchange of clinical experiences enriched the academic discussions and enhanced the learning experience for all attendees.

MULTI SPECIALTY CONFERENCE ON SUNDAY, 26TH JULY 2026



REPORT : MULTI SPECIALTY CONFERENCE ON SUNDAY, 26TH JULY 2026

CME Conveners : Dr. Bimal Shah, Dr. Bhavna Patel, Dr. Rashmi Mehta and Dr. Shalin Soni.

The Continuing Medical Education (CME) programme organised by the CGP Sub-Faculty of the IMA Mumbai West Branch was successfully conducted on 26th July 2026 at the IMA Auditorium, IMA, Juhu. The program commenced at 9:15 AM with a warm welcome and introductory address by Dr. Bimal Shah and Dr. Bhavna Patel.

The first lecture was delivered by **Dr. Bhavin Desai**, Paediatrician, on **“Diarrhoea and Prevention of Dehydration in Paediatric Patients.”** He began by defining diarrhoea and dehydration, followed by a discussion on the epidemiology and various types of dehydration. He highlighted the danger signs requiring urgent attention and emphasised preventive strategies to avoid dehydration in children. Dr. Desai also traced the evolution of Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS) from 1975 to the present day, explained the composition of the current WHO-recommended ORS & discussed the WHO management plans for dehydration.

The second lecture was presented by **Dr. Riya Bimal Shah**, Dental Surgeon, on **“The Art of Conservative Dentistry.”** She explained the concept and evolution of conservative dentistry and described the anatomy of the tooth and the process of dental caries. She elaborated on various restorative procedures, ranging from traditional methods such as silver amalgam restorations to modern techniques including composite restorations, inlays, onlays, veneers, crowns, and dental implants.

The third session was conducted by **Mr. Nichill Joseph**, Branch Manager, AU Small Finance Bank, on **“Banking Beyond Transactions.”** He provided an overview of the various banking services offered by the bank, including savings schemes, credit card facilities, insurance products, and financial planning solutions tailored to customers' needs.

The fourth lecture was delivered by **Dr. Gaurav Daga**, Nephrologist, on **“Redefine CKD Care – Manage Hyperkalaemia, Enable GDMT.”** He discussed the prevalence of chronic kidney disease (CKD) in India and explained the various causes and clinical implications of hyperkalaemia. He reviewed both non-pharmacological and pharmacological treatment options and introduced the newer potassium binder **Lokelma**, explaining its mechanism of action, dosage, and role in enabling guideline-directed medical therapy (GDMT).

The fifth lecture was presented by **Dr. Jignesh Gandhi**, Robotic Surgeon, on **“Laparoscopy to Robotic Surgery.”** He described the evolution of minimally invasive surgery and highlighted the advantages of robotic surgery for both patients and surgeons. Through several clinical case scenarios, he demonstrated the benefits of robotic-assisted surgery, particularly in managing complex surgical procedures.

The sixth lecture was delivered by **Dr. Akshay Mehta**, Cardiologist, on **“Lipid Management 2026.”** He explained the process of atherogenesis and emphasized the importance of measuring Apolipoprotein B (ApoB) and Lipoprotein(a) [Lp(a)] as markers for assessing the risk of atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD). He stressed the need for early lipid screening and discussed lifestyle modifications alongside pharmacological therapy for ASCVD prevention. He also highlighted the clinical significance of coronary artery calcium scoring in cardiovascular risk assessment.

MULTI SPECIALTY CONFERENCE ON SUNDAY, 26TH JULY 2026



The seventh and final lecture was delivered by **Dr. Snigdha Mehta**, Physiotherapist, on **“Transform the Way You Move with the Right Physiotherapy.”** She discussed **Dormant Butt Syndrome**, a condition resulting from prolonged sitting that leads to weakened gluteal muscles and subsequent musculoskeletal pain and impaired movement. She demonstrated a series of exercises to strengthen the gluteal muscles and also explained the importance of Kegel exercises for maintaining pelvic floor muscle health.

The CME concluded with an engaging interactive discussion session, during which participants actively exchanged ideas and clarified their queries with the faculty. The program ended with a vote of thanks, expressing sincere appreciation to the speakers, organisers, sponsors, and attendees for their valuable contributions in making the CME a grand success.
